

A change to daily pickup routines

From next week all morning tea and lunch boxes which still have food left in them after mealtimes will be put back into the fridge until parents arrive for pickup.

Staff have been making sure these are in your child's bag/locker for you after lunch, but we are aware that this means quite a lot of food goes to waste.

So, please be sure to check the fridge for your child's lunch/morning tea boxes before leaving each day.

We have noticed that many children have a large amount of food provided each day, and quite often only eat small amounts at morning tea or lunch. Usually, 1 or 2 things are enough for morning tea, and a sandwich, yoghurt, fruit etc for lunch.

We are experiencing a large increase in child absences at preschool in this last week or so due to illness, both Covid 19, and coughs and colds.

A reminder please for all families to be alert for symptoms in your children, and keep them at home from preschool if at all unwell, and particularly if they have Covid like symptoms.

Children will be sent home if they are unwell during the day ie have a continual runny nose, persistent coughing, or raised temperature.

If anyone in your house has a positive Covid result, both you and your children are considered close contacts and are not able to attend preschool for 7 days from the date of the positive test, as per the preschools Covid Management policy.
