TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The aim of this playgroup is to build your child's play skills and development with your support. Educators will provide an educational focus for the Playgroup with selected activities based around their knowledge of early childhood development and your child's interests.

Times - 9:30am – 11:00am Wednesday mornings during NSW terms

Our playgroup is funded specifically for children under preschool age (ie 18 mths-3 yrs old) as a pathway to preschool.

Cost is \$5 per family per session, paid on arrival by cash or EFT

NB: If you or your child are unwell we ask that you do not attend Playgroup

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- Educators working with preschool children are not available to supervise Playgroup child/ren due to regulations with required ratios of adults to children attending preschool. Therefore, it is imperative that a parent or responsible adult is present and with their Playgroup child(ren) at all times while playgroup is on.
It is understood that Playgroup educators are available to support parents and carers in play with their children, but that children will not be left in the care of educators.
- Personal devices capable of taking photographs are no longer permitted in early childhood care services in NSW, whilst enrolled children are attending. For this reason, **we ask that your phone stays in the foyer or your car during playgroup.**
- Educators may use preschool devices to take photos of playgroup activities. Authorisation for photographs and filming will be obtained from Playgroup parents and strictly adhered to by educators and management.
Due to safety concerns and requirements for early childhood services, hot drinks are not allowed in children's play areas. We ask that you wait till after Playgroup for coffee/tea.
- From time to time, young children have disagreements in play. It is expected that parents monitor their own child's behaviour and work with other parents and Playgroup educators, if necessary to solve these disputes. The preschool can take no responsibility for the actions of Playgroup children which may result in another child getting hurt.
- It is expected that parents will make sure that both they and their children adhere to the Preschools' sun protection policy i.e. wear a hat, use sunscreen, wear t-shirts with sleeves. A full copy of this policy is available on the Playgroup section of the website.
- This year we have a number of children with anaphylaxis to some foods. In 2026 please **DO NOT** pack mango, nuts or eggs in your child's morning tea.
- Parents are responsible for their children's toileting and nappy changing requirements whilst at playgroup.
- The preschool playground is designed to cater for children aged 3 to 6 years old and there are some areas that require close adult supervision for younger children, such as the climbing log and platform above the slippery dip. In these locations you will need to be within reach of your child at all times. Due to the size of our playground it is imperative that you always know where your child is when outdoors.
- To avoid injury, the deck area is a **walk only zone** and **no trike** area, as it can often become very crowded and busy.
